

Cricklewood Silk Road Festival 2013

Cricklewood is hosting its second annual Silk Road Festival from 1-7 September 2013. These events form part of a £1.67 million investment in Cricklewood through the Mayor of London's Outer London Fund, a three-year initiative which is helping increase the vibrancy and growth of high streets across London. The term *silk road* captures the present day role of the centre as a commercial route into and out of London.

Cricklewood Mobile Town Square

Cricklewood Mobile Town Square is a temporary public space which will move across Cricklewood this summer, reclaiming forgotten patches of land and transforming them into civic space for the community to use: space to sit, rest, meet, eat and do. During the Silk Road Festival, the Square will be located at the Railway Terrace steps, opposite Matalan, from Saturday 1st to Friday 6th September, before moving to Beacon Bingo from Saturday 7th onwards.
